





Figure 2: National Truck Usage, 1st Quarter 2015








A truck is assumed to carry 55,000 lbs or 25 metric tons of grain. Rates per metric ton per mile can be calculated from rates per truckload.


Figure 4: National Average Truck Rates by Trip Distance


