Certification of USDA High Volume Instrument (HVI) Calibration Standards

USDA HVI calibration standards are established by the Standardization and Engineering Division of the AMS Cotton and Tobacco Program in Memphis, Tennessee, USA. The official USDA logo on USDA standards serves as certification of the authenticity of USDA HVI standards. USDA HVI standards are accepted as the official international standard for HVI calibration under the Universal Cotton Standards Agreement which is governed by national cotton associations in 22 countries. In addition, the International Cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC) has adopted USDA HVI standards as the official standard by way of the ICAC Task Force on Commercial Standardization of Instrumentation for Testing Cotton. The International Textile Manufacturers Federation recognizes only USDA HVI standards for HVI calibration by way of the ITMF publication "HVI User Guide". There is no other standard for HVI calibration that is governed and recognized on an international basis.
