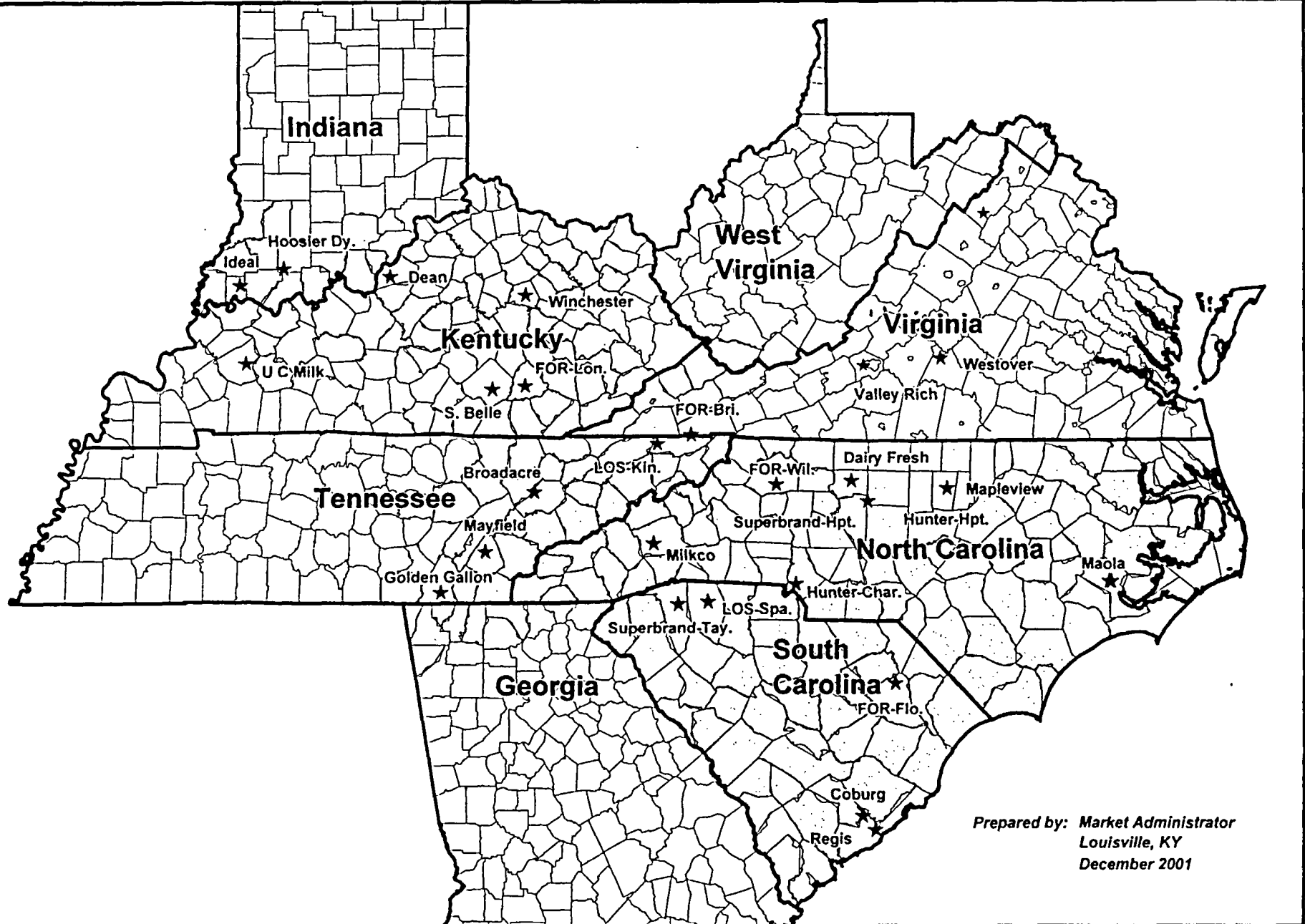

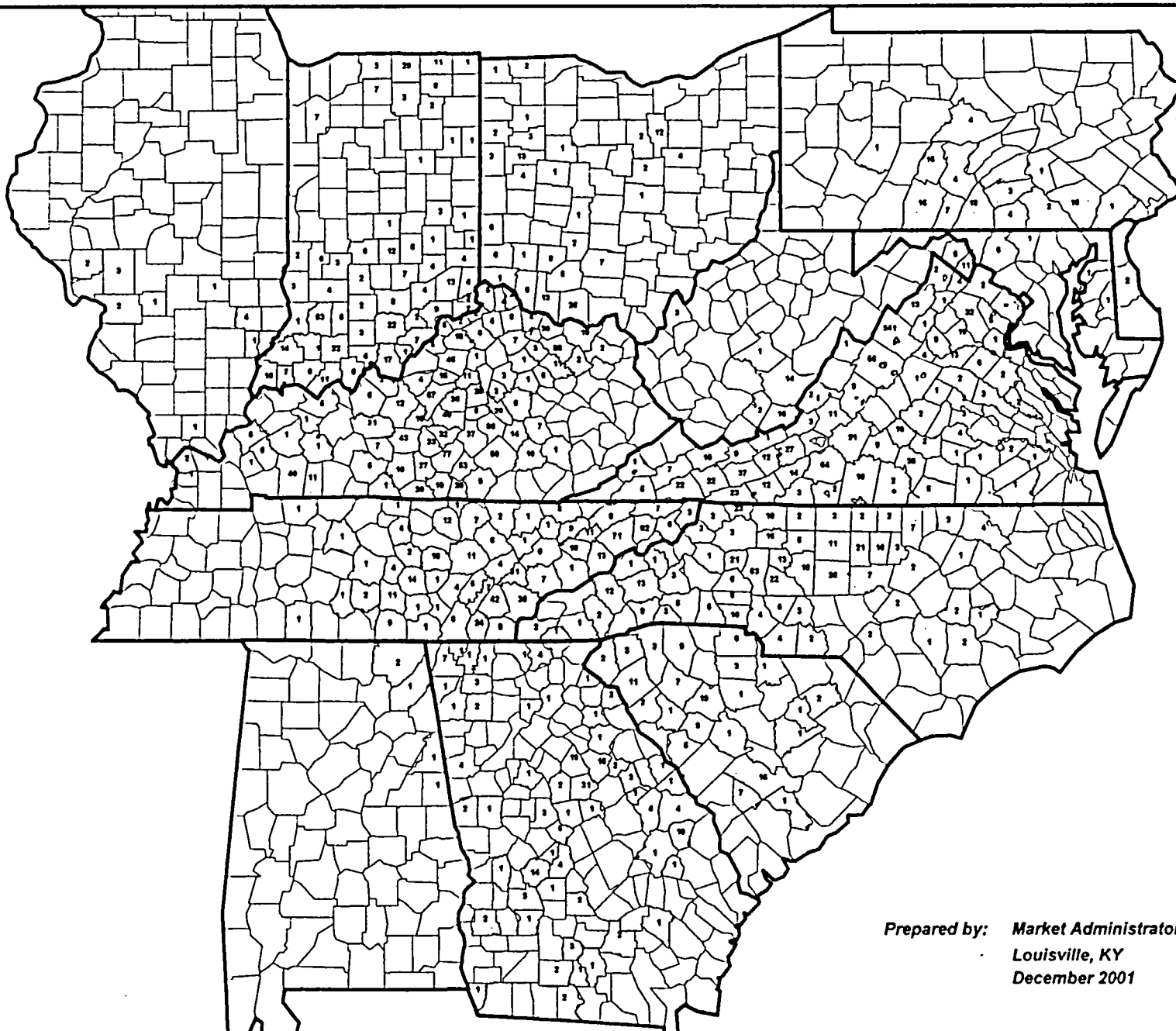
Pool Distributing Plants
