I am writing to request information for our preparation for an upcoming hearing. As we are preparing our position we need some data from your staff for the upcoming Order 33 hearing. We also understand that you have received a data request from Dairy Farmers of America ("DFA"). We are interested in receiving your responses to that and any other requests. The purpose of this request is to supplement, not require duplication of, your earlier efforts. We would like your staff to prepare the following:

- 1) Following one of DFA's requests in which FO #33 was broken into 3 regions (NW, NE and South (I-70 south).
 - a. Percent of milk to each region's distributing plants from producers located in Order 33 but divided by region (e.g. N.W. Order dairy production delivered to plants in South); and
 - b. Percent of milk produced outside FO #33 and delivered to each region's distributing plants.
- 2) Model the blend price for Jan 03 to the present assuming the proposed amendment had been in place.
 - a. Show the effect relative to actual for a producer delivering to the following plants
 - i. Battle Creek, MI
 - ii. Fair Oaks, IN
 - iii. Canton, OH
- 3) Pounds of milk pooled on FO #33 but diverted to plants located outside of the marketing area for Jan-03 to current.
