FSMIP Peer Reviewer Application Instructions March 2015

The Agricultural Marketing Service is seeking peer reviewers to evaluate FSMIP grant applications. *April 27, 2015*, is the deadline to be considered to serve during fiscal year (FY) 2015, but you may submit an application at any time to be added to our database for consideration in future years.

A FSMIP PEER REVIEW APPLICANT MUST:

- (1) Be employed by one of the following:
 - The Federal government
 - A State department of agriculture
 - A land grant university or college, including an 1862, 1890 or 1994 institution
 - A State university or State college, or
 - A State agency such as a State department of Forestry, Energy, Natural Resources, etc.

(2) Have general knowledge of food/agricultural marketing, applied economics and/or experience working with and advising farmers and ranchers on some aspect of marketing; AND/OR

(3) Have specialized knowledge about one or more of the following:

Agriculture/Resource Economics Consumer Economics Extension Food and/or Agricultural Marketing Food Safety Foreign Market Development/Exports Labeling/Branding Local/Regional Food Systems New Uses for Agricultural Products Post-harvest Handling Product Development/Testing Producer Training/Technical Assistance Rural Economic Development Transportation/Logistics/Distribution Sector-Specific Marketing/Economics - Aquaculture - Bioenergy - Dairy - Forestry/Wood Products - Horticulture/Nursery - Livestock, Meat, Poultry - Specialty Crops Other (please specify)

Before applying, please read the press release to get a general sense of the FSMIP review process and the responsibilities of a peer reviewer. Note that:

- FY 2015 FSMIP grant applicants are not eligible to serve as reviewers in FY 2015. This means you and your employer cannot be involved in any way with a FY 2015 proposal, either as the primary investigator or a partner.
- Reviewers will not evaluate proposals for which they or their organizations have a conflict of interest.

 - (b) A signed AMS Conflict-Of-Interest & Confidentiality Statement for Review Panelists;
 - (c) In the body of the email message, provide:

(i) The name and category designation of your employer [see (1) above]; and

(ii) A list of the topics headings that best represents your specialized knowledge [see (3) above].
