

Application for Market Access and Re-registration for Feeds and Feed Ingredients to China

The General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine (AQSIQ) of the People's Republic of China requires that U.S. feed and feed stuffs intended for export to China apply for **market access** if they: A) are new to market and have not been exported before, or **Re-registration B)** are not new to market, but are not currently registered with AQSIQ. This application may be used by manufacturers of feed products that meet those criteria to apply for market access for exporting to China.

Instructions for Completion of the Application for Service covering Market Access and Re-registration for Feeds and Feed Ingredients to China

· General Instructions for Worksheet

The application must be completed in a legible manner (typed preferably).

1. **Producer/Manufacturer:** Name and address of the natural or legal person or entity that has produced the consignment.
2. **Billing Information:** Name and address (street, town and region/province/state, as applicable) of the natural or legal person or entity arranging payment of services provided by AMS.
3. **Applying for Market Access:** Check this box if your product is not currently registered with AQSIQ, and has not been previously registered with AQSIQ within the last 5 years.
- 3a. **Applying for Re-registration:** Check this box if your product was previously registered with AQSIQ within the last 5 years, and documents can be provided to AMS showing commercial shipments for that period.
4. **Point of Contact:** A company representative identified to serve as the point of contact.
5. **Telephone:** Identify the phone number for the designated representative for the exporting company.
6. **Fax number:** Identify the number for receipt of a facsimile transmission.
7. **Contact email:** Email address for correspondence with designated company contact.
8. **Name of Product (include description):** Commercial name of product with specific description of the individual product(s). Include the applicable harmonized schedule code.
9. **Product Description:** Brief description of product to include but not limited to sales sheet, MSDS, and product application and usage.
10. **Importer:** Name and address of the person or entity that is responsible for ensuring that legal goods are imported in accordance with Chinese law.
