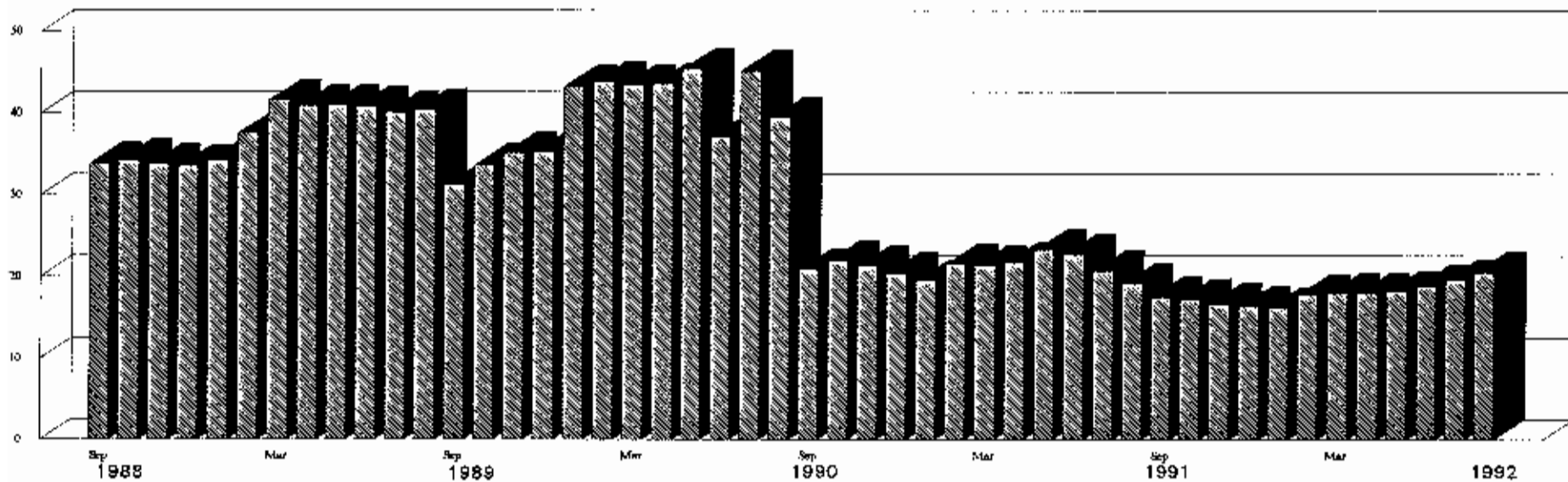

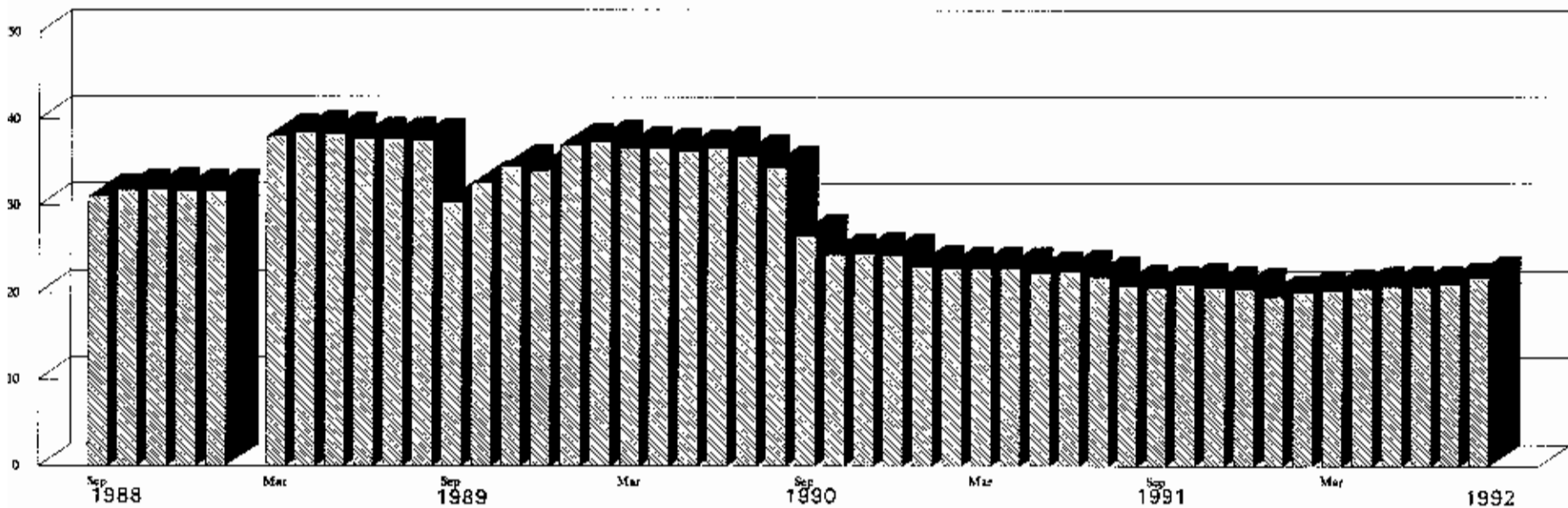
Pintos - Northern Colorado

Dealer Prices



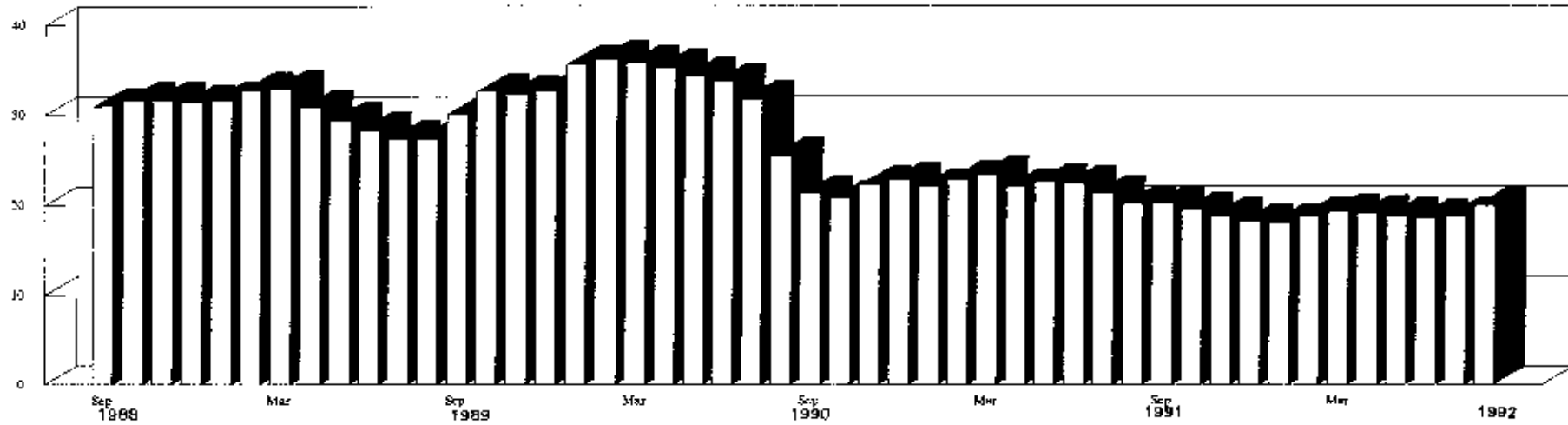
Pinks - Southern Idaho

Dealer Prices



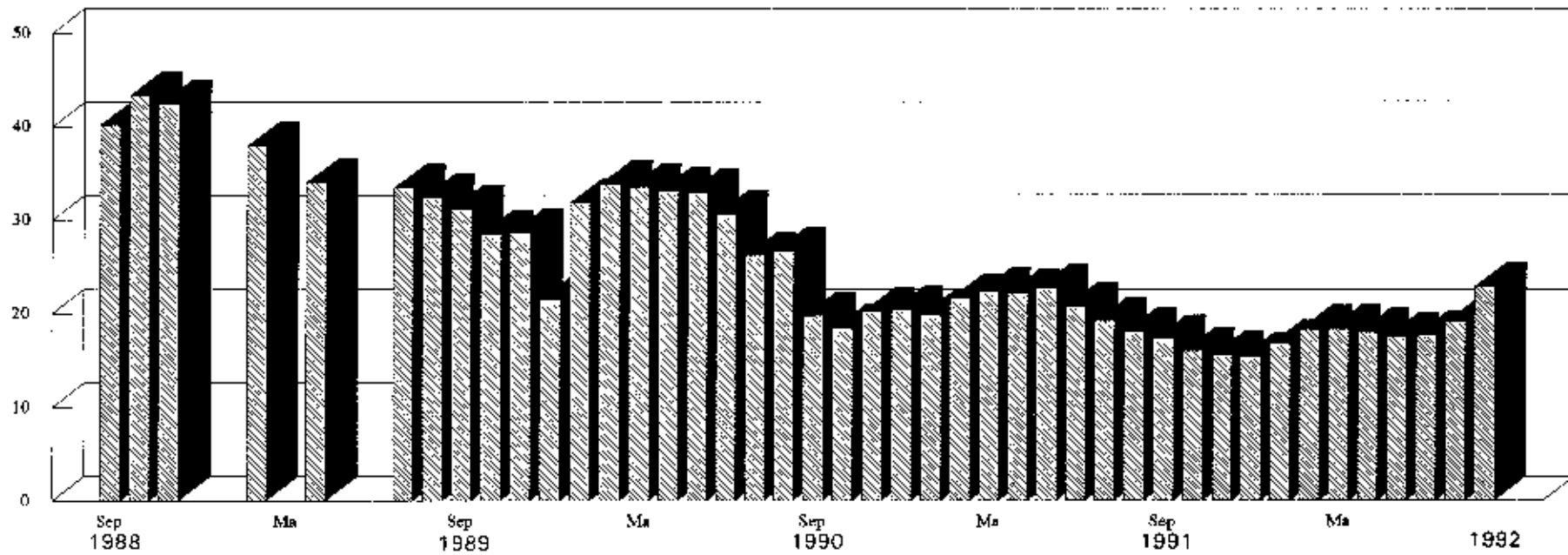
