Chart 1: U.S. Head Lettuce Supply

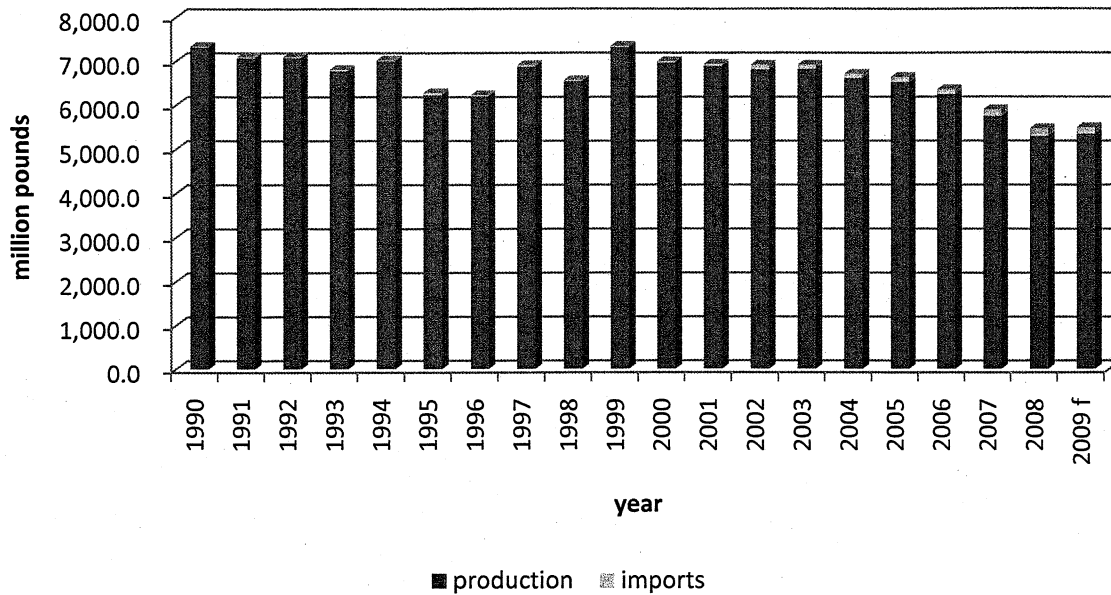


Chart 2: U.S. Head Lettuce Utilization

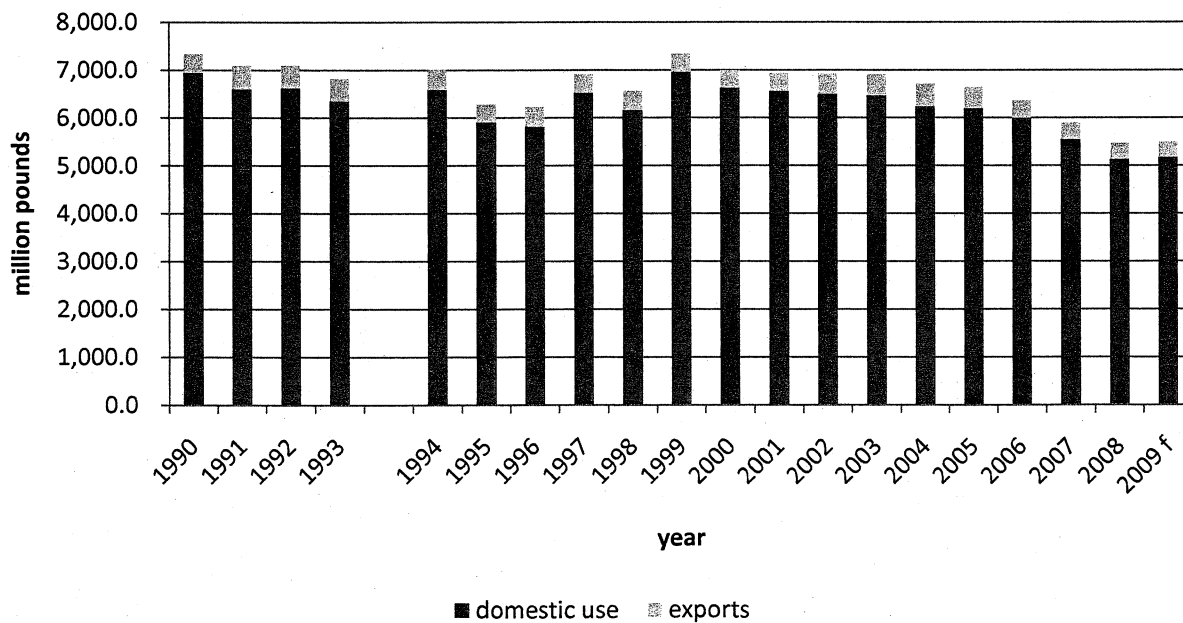

Chart 3: U.S. Leaf and Romaine Lettuce Supply

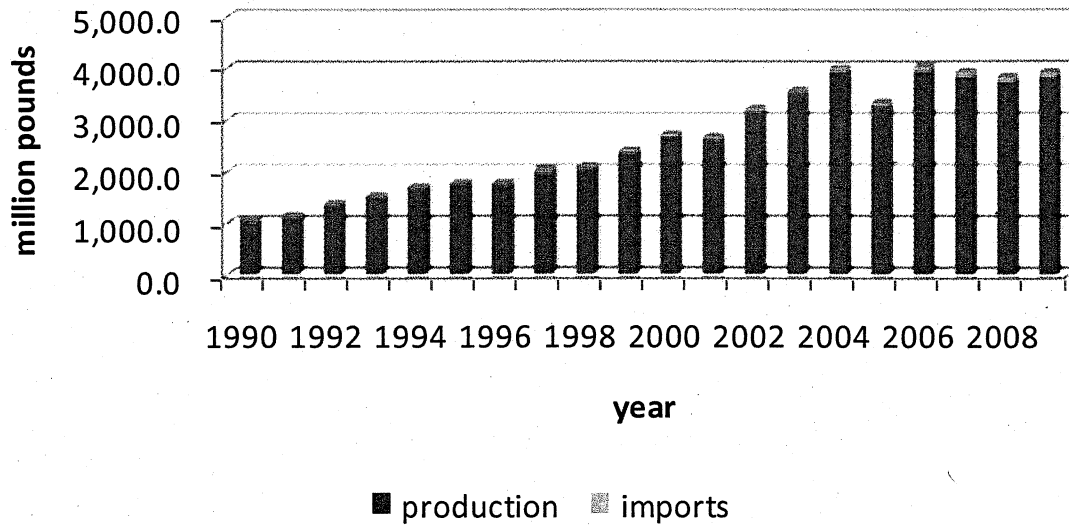
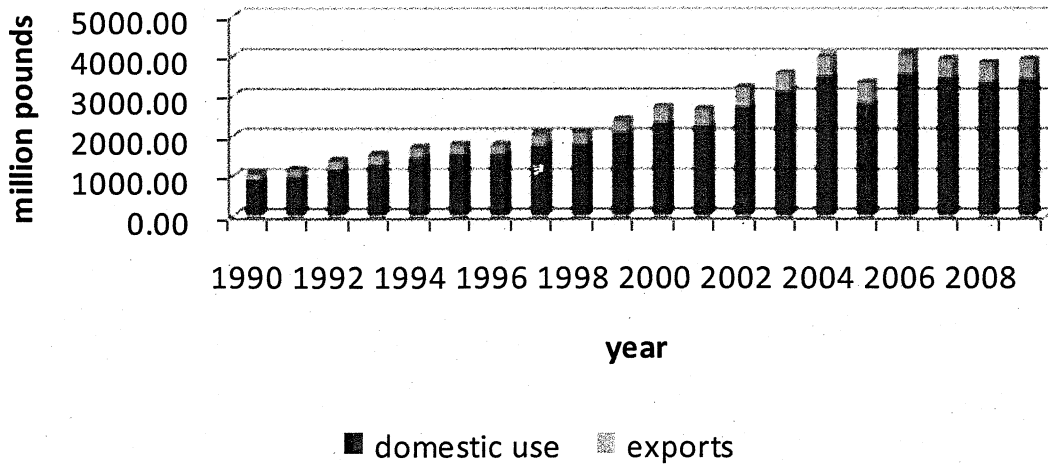


Chart 4: U.S. Leaf and Romaine Lettuce Utilization

Chart 5: U.S. Fresh Spinach Supply

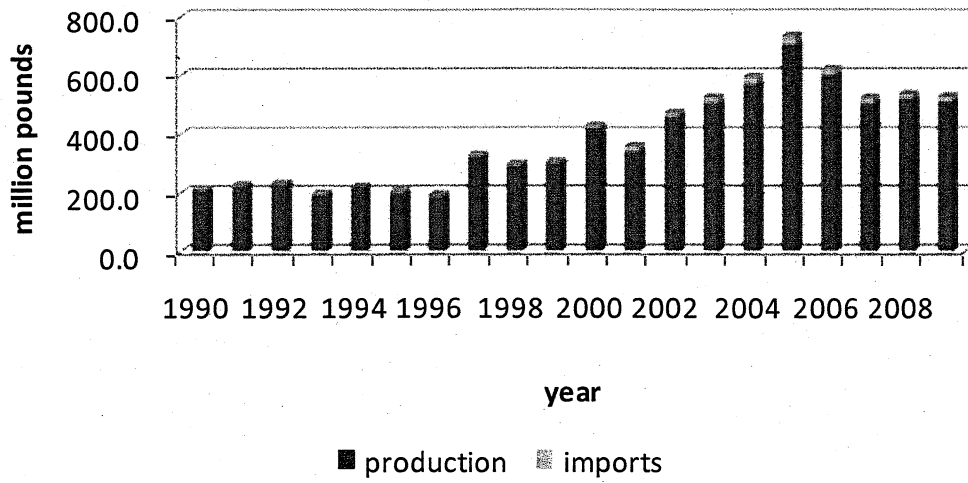


Chart 6: U.S. Fresh Spinach Utilization

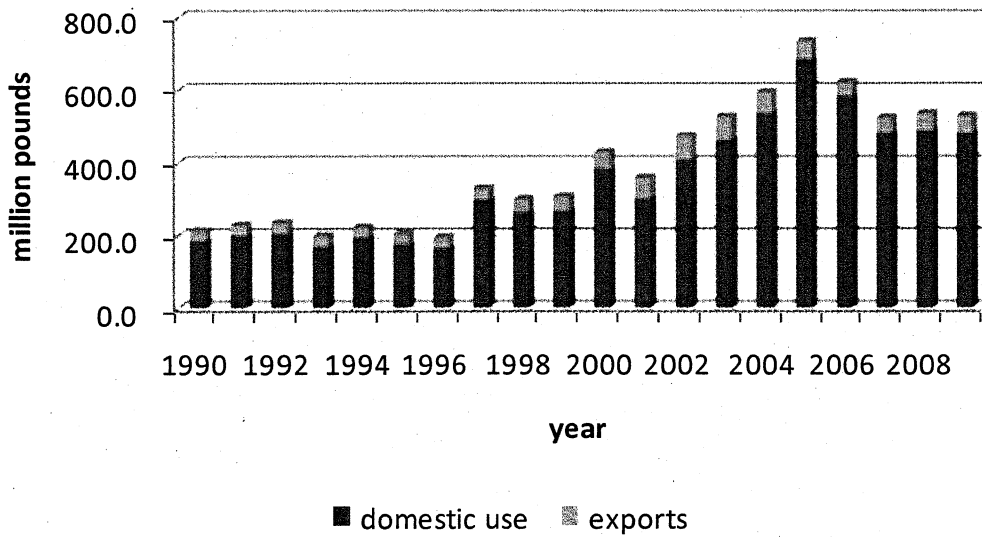

Chart 7: U.S. Fresh Cabbage Supply

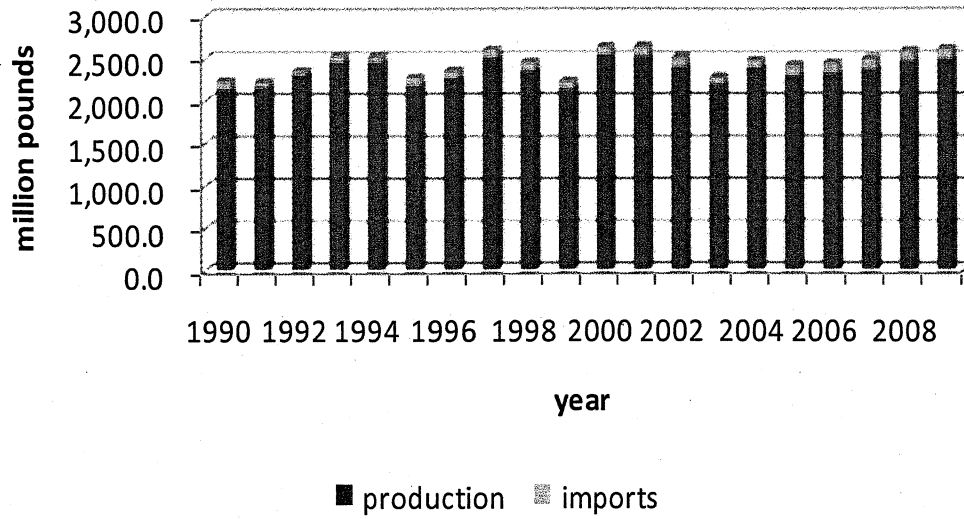


Chart 8: U.S. Fresh Cabbage Utilization

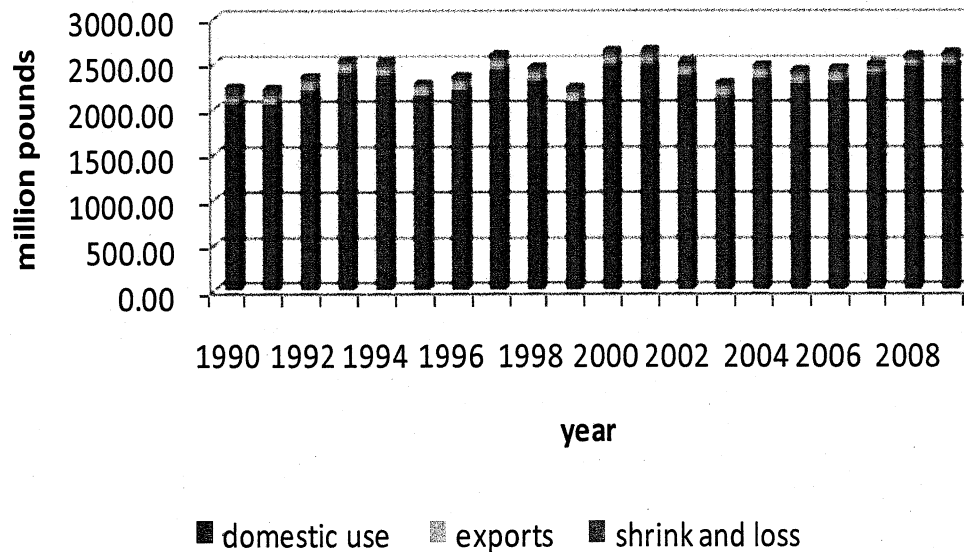

Chart 9: U.S. Production of Major Fresh Leafy Greens

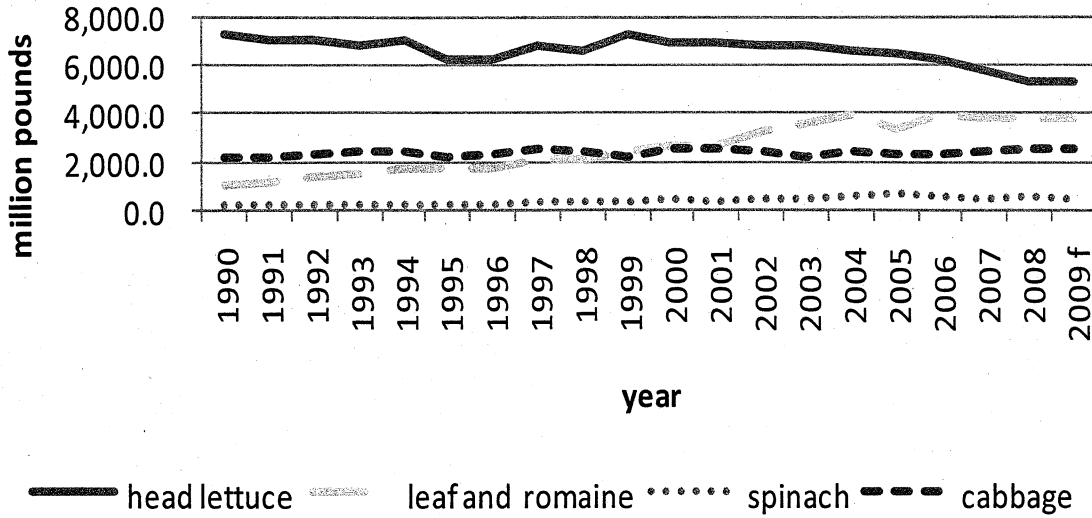


Chart 10: Season Average Grower Prices for Major Fresh Leafy Greens

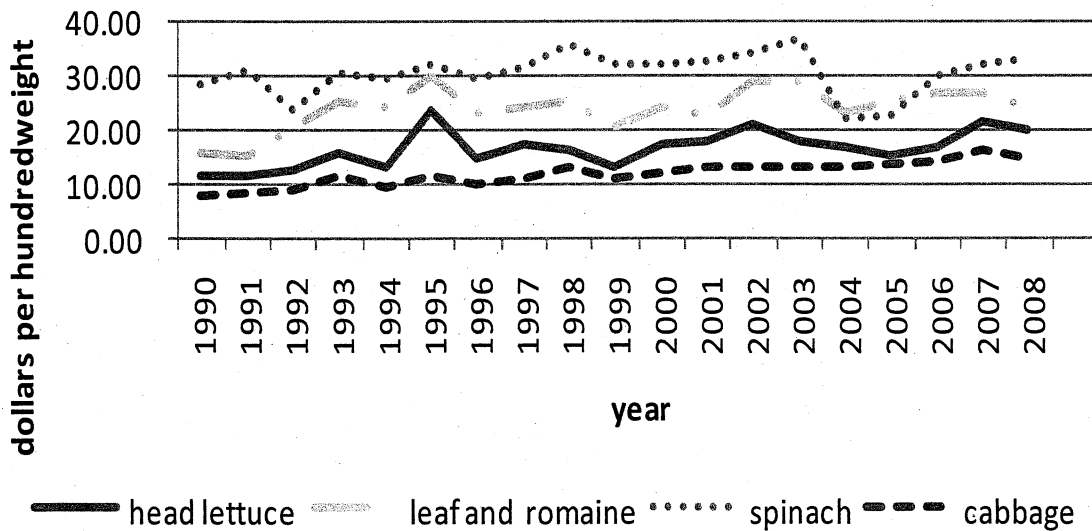
